**Progress Update:**

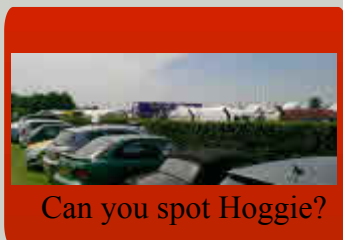
